CG 3MT 2026 Call - Technical Criteria

In principle, the University of Queensland Rules for video entries apply to the Coimbra Group competition. Please make sure to consult them [here](#).

The Coimbra Group applies **further technical specifications** to ensure uniformity, comparability, and technical simplicity across all video entries.

Accepted formats: Recordings from both in-person and online competitions are eligible, provided the performance is delivered **live** (even if online).

✗ Edited / Compiled versions (best version of several recorded ones) will not be accepted.

CG 3MT 2026 Call - Technical criteria

A single static slide is permitted.  No slide transitions, animations or 'movement' of any type are allowed. The slide must be visible from the beginning of the oration.

 No additional electronic media (e.g. sound or video files) may be used.

 No props (e.g. costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.

Presentations are limited to 3 minutes maximum.

 *Competitors exceeding this time limit will be disqualified.*

Presentations must be delivered in **spoken word only** (e.g. no poems, raps or songs).

Presentations must **commence from the stage**.

Presentations are considered to have **commenced when the presenter begins** speaking or moving.

 *Don't use extras beeps, signals or other cues to start.*

The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.

Additional technical specifications for videos

- Videos must be recorded at a live institutional 3MT event. **✗** “Studio” recordings are not permitted.
- **The presentation by the doctoral researcher must stand on its own:** **✗** Oral introductions at the event must not be included, nor may any opening credits or overlays be added by the producers.
- Videos must be as simple as possible. Use a **single, static camera shot** pointing at the candidate.
- **✗ Video editing is not allowed:**
 - No credits.
 - No music.
 - No introductions.
 - Only one slide illustrating the talk.
- **Sound must be of good quality.** Please use a clear microphone.
- **✗ Computers or other devices are not allowed** during the presentation.
- It is strongly recommended that the presenter's **full body is visible** throughout the recording.
- **✗ Edited or non-compliant recordings** will be excluded from the Coimbra Group 3MT competition by the technical committee.

Some content specifications

- **RESULTS!** *The 3MT is about communicating research results, not mere research plans.*

- ✓ Highlight the outcomes of your research.
- ✓ Avoid overstatements.
- ✓ Make your presentation easy for everyone to understand.
- ✓ Avoid trivialisation.
