

Credentials and Login



Back to the F.A.Q.s

We mostly use the "eduroam" network. For what concerns the credentials, the username is YOURFISCALCODE@UNIPV.IT and the password is the password of your personal area.

Can I use the Ethernet cable to connect my computer?

Yes, you can connect your PC with an Ethernet cable. Before doing this, you must contact Gabriele Merli (gabriele.merli@unipv.it) in order to register your device.

Computers and Clusters

Are there any computer I can use at the department?

Back to the F.A.Q.s

You can use all the computers in "Laboratorio Informatico", at floor A (ground floor). To log in, you should use the credentials of your UNIPV personal area.

What if I need a new laptop/computer/tablet? Back to the F.A.Q.s

You can buy any tech item you need for work. Each of them will remain at the Department of Mathematics once you leave. To buy one, you should firstly ask for permission to your advisor/tutor. Then, you should fill the module "Ordini per materiale informatico" available at the following link: https://matematica.unipv.it/risorse-utili/modulistica-amministrazione/. Lastly, you should send the filled module at Gabriele Merli (gabriele.merli@unipv.it), Patrizia Bova (patrizia.bova@unipv.it), and Marco Manelli (marco.manelli@unipv.it).

What if I need to print?

You should ask to Gabriele Merli (Office A17), to configure the printer on your personal devices.


What if I need extra computing power?

Conferences, Workshops, Seminars

Moving



Every time you move outside Pavia for research activities you have to open a mission. Even if you don't want to request any reimbursement, the mission must be opened for insurance reasons.

When do I open the mission?

Back to the F.A.Q.s

The mission should be opened before departure. You cannot open it after the departure. It's common sense to open it a few days before the start to facilitate the work of the administrative staff.

Where do I open the mission?

Back to the F.A.Q.s

The link to open a mission is https://missioni.unipv.it/. Log in with your credentials (fiscal code and password or SPID) and follow the instructions. In this page you can find several information in the help section.

- ▶ On the top-left corner click on "New claim";
- ▶ In the "Destination" window that is now opened, insert the location and the start and end dates of the mission. You don't need to be sharp with the time so you can insert 00:00 in the start time and 23:59 in the end time. To avoid problems like delays and cancellations, it is suggested to insert one day before the "true" departure and one day after the "true" arrival;
- ► Insert "DR Borse di dottorato" in the title box and the start location (usually "Pavia");
- ▶ In "Type of Request" select "RIC Progetti(fondi ricerca/conto terzi)";
- ▶ In "Head of Project" insert the owner of the funds (usually your tutor or the coordinator). You can leave the "Project" box empty, the owner can fill it. "Structure concerned" and "Paying structure" boxes should now be auto-filled;
- ▶ In "Regulation" select "TES REGOLAMENTO DI ATENEO";
- Describe briefly the object of your mission in the "Reason" box;
- Don't forget to write: "Dichiaro che le attività connesse con la presente missione devono essere necessariamente svolte fuori sede e che per i documenti di viaggio allegati non verrà richiesto il rimborso da parte di altra amministrazione." in the "Notes" box;
- ▶ In "Special means" you have to insert all the non-ordinary means of transport (taxi, car...) that you have planned to take during your journey. Usually, you will not obtain reimbursement for these means unless you prove that they are necessary or cheaper than ordinary means;
- Finally, in "Expenses with estimate" you have to insert the list of the expenses for which you want reimbursement. This is a preventive so you can exceed the cost.

After you have returned from your journey you have to close the mission. Log in with your credentials and close it. After that, you can insert all the receipts for which you want the reimbursement. First, you have to compile the section related to the special means, and then the expenses incurred. For every voice that you insert you have to select the corresponding type. Some types have a daily limit, for example, a voice of type "ALBER" has a daily limit of $200\mathbb{C}$. Note that for the "PASTS" type you can spend $35,50\mathbb{C}$ for lunch and breakfast and $35,50\mathbb{C}$ for dinner. When you insert the receipts related to this voice split dinner and lunch. If you insert a single voice for dinner and lunch of $70\mathbb{C}$, the system will give you an error because the limit is $35,50\mathbb{C}$. If you insert two voices you avoid this problem and you can also put an expense of $40\mathbb{C}$ for lunch and an expense of $30\mathbb{C}$ for dinner without errors. All the receipts must be inserted in pdf/a format, if you insert a "standard" pdf you will obtain an error. Don't forget to insert a document that proves your presence, such as the Certificate of Attendance.


Is my increase of 10% available for workshop/conferences? Back to the F.A.Q.s

Yes, your 10% is available. Remember to ask your advisor/tutor the permission to use it.

I've finished my 10%. Is there any other money? Back to the F.A.Q.s


You can ask your advisor/tutor if it has some funds for you. There are also residues from past PhD students that are available. For this fund, you have to ask the PhD coordinators and to the secretariat. Don't forget to subscribe to your INDAM group https://www.altamatematica.it/gruppi-di-ricerca/gruppi-nazionali/ to ask for extra money a couple of times p er year.

At the Department



Here is a short list:

- ► The Department of Mathematics of UniPV and the CNR Institute IMATI "E. Magenes" of Pavia organize seminars on applied mathematics periodically, mostly on Tuesday afternoons. The referring professor is Prof. Stefano Lisini (UniPV) and the mailing list is "seminarimartedi".
- ► The Department of Mathematics of UniPV also organizes "Seminari Geometria e Algebra".
- ► The mailing list "seminarimartedi" also sponsors seminars from other departments—often international—of akin disciplines, like Physics and Engineering. In this case, the referring professor is Dr. Lorenzo Tamellini.
- ▶ The University of Milano Bicocca keeps a series named *Insalate di Matematica*. It presents topics that are connected to the research themes at the Department of Mathematics and Applications of Milano Bicocca. They try to give an overall view on the subject, no particular prerequisites are needed.


Caffè Beltrami We chair an informal series of seminars for graduate and undergraduate students lectured by Ph.D., called Caffè Beltrami: the goal is to present—in an accessible way—topics that might be sound exotic to students, either because they are not analyzed in depth during standard courses or are active research themes. Also, this is an occasion for the students to know what research topics are active in the Department and to connect with Ph.D. students (both here and from other universities).

Il TeX delle cinque We also have an ongoing series of lectures on intermediate to advanced topics in the use of (LATeX and related software of packages. Moving abroad



At UNIPV, there are mostly three call you can apply for:

- ► Erasmus Traineeship: PhD students can also apply. You will receive an email once the call is open. The contribution is made up of two parts: one part depends on the country you choose and the other one depends on your reddito ISEE. All the info here: https://internazionale.unipv.eu/it/erasmus-traineeship-all-estero/
- ▶ "Bando Mobilità": This call can found you for three months abroad and it's opened "randomly" during the year. Note: this is not compatible with the part "Reddito ISEE" of the Erasmus Traineeship scholarship. All the info here http://phd.unipv.it/ bandi-per-borse-di-mobilita-internazionale/
- ➤ You can ask for the increase of 50% of your scholarship. The detailed procedure can be found here: http://phd.unipv.it/istruzioni-estero-dottorandi-titolari-di-borsa-di-dottorato/

Note: every time you move, you should open a mission for insurance reasons.


Math: at least 3 months in an other department

Duty of the students and exams

Which are my duties as a PhD Student?

Back to the F.A.Q.s

- ▶ Within the first 18 months, you are supposed to do 30 CFU. Each attended course provides you an amount of CFU. If you also do the exam of such course, you will receive one extra CFU. If a course does not provide you CFU, use the conversion 4h = 1 CFU. **Note**: online courses are allowed if with exams. If you do not plan to do the exam, then to make it accepted, you need an approval of the tutor and a certification (even informal) by the course teacher certifying that the course has actually been followed.
- At the end of the academic year (you will get an e-mail) you should submit a report indicating attended course, schools, seminars, etc., attaching a copy of the certificate of attendance and possibly the final exam. The report should also contain the status of the scientific activity (status of the doctoral project, presentations held at conferences and workshops, any publications, etc.).
- ▶ At the end of the academic year you should prepare a 10 minutes presentation briefly describing the status of your research project.
- ▶ If you are a **PhD Student in "Matematica**", you should also do at least three months of visiting at any university different from Pavia
- ▶ If you are a PhD Student in "Computational Mathematics and Decision Sciences", you should also do at least six months at Università della Svizzera Italiana (Lugano).
