Directed and produced by Ian Cheney, Sharon Shattuck, and Manette Pottle, the film follows the experiences of biologist Nancy Hopkins, chemist Raychelle Burks, and geologist Jane Willenbring as they navigate discrimination ranging from overt harassment to persistent, subtle biases. Through their personal narratives and insights from social scientists, neuroscientists, and psychologists, the documentary sheds light on the structural barriers within the scientific community and highlights pathways towards meaningful change.
