This event will offer participants the opportunity to meet professionals who have built international careers in various global fields.

The event includes training workshops and interactive visits to organizations and European institutions, where experts will share their experiences and provide valuable advice on how to build a successful global career.

The program, open to CCUM students from all academic disciplines, offers a unique multidisciplinary experience, with visits to European institutions and a focus on international careers. Participants will explore how diverse knowledge is essential in a global context and will have the chance to build an international network of contacts, opening new doors for their professional future.

What's the goal?

During the Study Visit you will be able to:

- Identify your strengths and professional goals by using practical tools to create effective CVs and cover letters, and confidently present yourself to potential employers through interactive exercises and group work.
- Build a strong personal brand using storytelling and communication techniques to highlight your values, passions, and skills, while also applying practical tools to enhance your online visibility and explore career opportunities.

Where & When?

This opportunity will take place from **21 to 24 October 2025, in Brussels (Belgium)**

What's in it for you?

- **Visit the European Parliament & Commission** to gain first-hand insights into EU career paths and internship opportunities.
- **Take part in a Role Play activity organised by the European Parliament**, offering a hands-on experience of parliamentary work and the EU legislative process.
- **Join a tailored EucA training session** focused on developing international soft skills and preparing for careers in European and international environments.
- **Engage in networking opportunities with peers** who share similar values, goals, and a strong interest in European affairs.
- **Benefit from an inclusive and stimulating environment** that fosters open dialogue, intercultural exchange, and the development of communication and networking skills in an international setting.

Are you the participant we are looking for?

The call is open to students who will be enrolled in the CCUM colleges for the upcoming 2025/2026 academic year.

You are seeking international job offers, internships and international opportunities. You have a strong interest in EU affairs, and actively engage in discussions on key European issues.

You have solid English skills (B2 level or higher)—fluency is not required, but you should be comfortable participating in discussions and expressing your ideas confidently.

What's included?

- Three nights (21, 22, and 23 October 2025) in a centrally located hostel in Brussels, in shared rooms.
- Some meals included: all buffet breakfasts, one lunch and one dinner.
- Access to the European Parliament Role Play game.
- Visits to selected European institutions.
- Workshops in Brussels delivered by EucA on European opportunities, soft skills, and networking techniques.
- Local transportation in Brussels.
- Travel insurance.
- Mandatory online training prior to departure.

- Networking opportunities with fellow students.
- Certificate of International Mobility (20 hours).

What's not included?

- International transport from/to Brussels.
- Remaining meals not covered in the program.
- Snacks and other additional personal expenses.

Application and Selection Process

Please be aware that the deadline for the application is **8 September 2025 at 14:00 (CET)**.

As part of your application, you will need to attach your CV in English as a PDF document (Max 3 MB)
The final list will be published in the second week of September.

Logistics

1. This event will be held in English in person in Brussels. No remote participation is possible.
2. Once your selection is confirmed by EucA, you need to book and pay autonomously for your means of transport to the events.
3. For the three nights of the event, you have included a spot in a shared room with other attendees of the event in a hostel provided and paid for by EucA. Extra nights must be booked and paid by you independently from the organizers.
4. The activities will start on **21 October at 20:00 h**; therefore, all students are required to be present by that time.
